The service procedure for replacing a radio speaker in a 1966 Corvette equipped with air conditioning is as follows:

- 1. Disconnect the battery ground cable.
- 2. Remove glove box compartment as an assembly.
- 3. Remove clock.
- 4. Disconnect both air conditioning control cables at doors.
- 5. Remove air conditioning knobs.
- 6. Remove center air conditioning duct.
- 7. Remove deforster duct.
- 8. Disconnect speaker wires.
- 9. Remove 4 speaker screws and remove speaker.
- 10. Remove transformer from old speaker and install on new speaker.
- 11. Position the new speaker and reverse procedure to install.
